Create straight, sharp lines using masking tape as a guide!

TECHNIQUES: TAPE



MATERIALS

- Ceramic Smooth Dinner Plate (SKU CMM 0170)
 - Masking Tape
 - Fan Paint Brush
- Medium Flat Paint Brushes (2)
 - Paint Colors: 66, 14, 45, 39

TIPS

- Wait until the paint is completely dry before moving to the next step.
- Remove the tape ASAP after you are done painting - don't wait for the paint to dry before you remove the tape.
- Don't add ANY water to your paint or it may bleed under the tape. Start with a dry brush for each step.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Using a fan paintbrush, paint the green basecoat with #14 Gum Drop. Let the paint dry, then paint a second coat of green.
2. Let the base coat dry completely. It will look chalky and be cool to the touch.
3. Use masking tape to mark the edges of six thick vertical stripes.
4. Using an medium flat paint brush, paint thick vertical stripes with #66 Pink Berry.
5. Remove tape as soon as you are finished painting.
6. Let the paint dry completely.
7. Use masking tape to mark the edges of six thick horizontal stripes.
8. Paint thick horizontal stripes with #66 Pink Berry.
9. Remove tape ASAP.
10. Let the paint dry completely.
11. Use two strips of masking tape, with a small gap in between, to tape off six thin vertical stripes.
12. Paint thin vertical stripes with #39 Blue Green.
13. Remove tape ASAP.
14. Let the paint dry completely.
15. Use two strips of masking tape with a small gap in between to tape off six thin horizontal stripes.
16. Paint thin horizontal stripes with #39 Blue Green.
17. Remove tape ASAP.
18. Glaze and fire.
